- **Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) 52.222-50:** This regulation addresses the prohibition of trafficking in persons and requires contractors to implement compliance plans and procedures.
- **California Transparency in Supply Chains Act of 2010:** This act mandates that companies disclose their efforts to eliminate slavery and human trafficking from their supply chains.
- **United Kingdom's Modern Slavery Act of 2015:** This legislation aims to consolidate offenses related to slavery and trafficking, ensuring severe penalties for perpetrators and requiring businesses to report on their efforts to combat modern slavery.

EDAC integrates respect for human rights across its global supply chain by:

- Mandating that suppliers comply with labor laws related to human trafficking and slavery.
- Requiring suppliers to certify their compliance with these laws through the acceptance of purchase orders.
- Conducting periodic audits of suppliers to assess compliance with relevant laws and company standards.
