

Uyghur Forced Labor Prevention Act (UFLPA) Compliance Statement

The Uyghur Forced Labor Prevention Act (UFLPA), signed into law on December 23, 2021, establishes a rebuttable presumption that goods mined, produced, or manufactured wholly or in part in the Xinjiang Uyghur Autonomous Region (XUAR) of China, or by entities on the UFLPA Entity List, are made with forced labor. As such, these goods are prohibited from being imported into the United States under Section 307 of the Tariff Act of 1930. This presumption took effect on June 21, 2022.

The presumption applies unless the Commissioner of U.S. CBP determines there is an exception through clear and convincing evidence, that the goods, wares, articles, or merchandise were not produced using forced labor or that UFLPA does not apply.

To comply with the UFLPA, EDAC certifies that its products are not produced wholly or in part in China's Xinjiang Uyghur Autonomous Region, nor are they produced by entities listed under the UFLPA Entity List.
